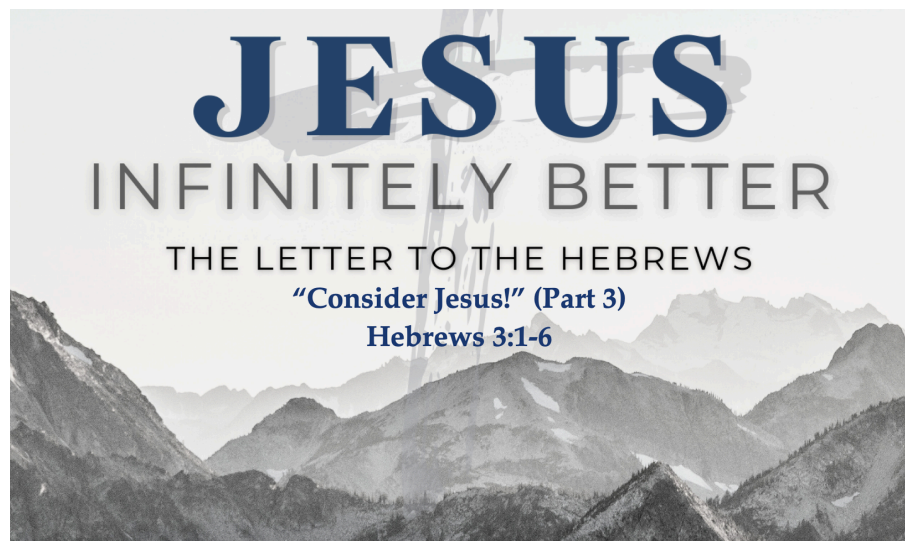

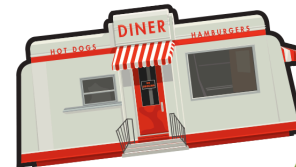

# Missionary Update Brooke & Dillon Weimar Missionaries in Thailand Our Return to the Land of Smiles



## Redemption

Our last stop of our trip was Arizona, which was such a redeeming trip. It's a place that holds a lot of pain for Brooke. And, yet, to see all the Lord has done in and through her life over the past ten years is nothing short of a miracle. To return with her godly husband, her son full of joy, and heart lightened by the Holy Spirit - it was God's mercy in full display. It was special for me to get to visit Arizona for the first time and experience some of her favorite places and memories as well.

## University Reunions

We visited Brooke's dear friend, Julie, from university as she is now a pastor at a Lutheran church in Sedona. She lived in Malaysia for a year a few years back. She visited us in Thailand and we visited her in Malaysia in 2022. What a surprising reunion back in Arizona! Her church was so so welcoming to us and it was special to share how God has been working in our lives over the past few years!

We were able to spend time with Brooke's pastor and mentor, Dr. Sanghoon Yoo, from college as well. He led us through our pre-marital counseling, continues to mentor her monthly, and also leads a trauma-informed care movement nationwide that Brooke has gotten to be a part of from overseas. We had the opportunity to share with this beautiful group and connect with others from there. We even met a woman, Linda, that knows a family of missionaries in Thailand that attended Brooke's school. God brings about the craziest connections!

## Reflection & Return

We are still processing all that the last three months have encapsulated. We haven't hit our monthly support goal yet, but we are confident that the Lord will provide in time. We have felt so encouraged by all that he's already laid before us thus far. Upon landing, we have been battling jet lag, recalibrating to Thai weather (and food!), cleaning and unpacking, and restocking our pantry. This coming Tuesday we will be attending a YWAM Conference in Khon Kaen, Thailand from October 14-18. We're thrilled that we get to join as a family for the first time. We'll get to see ministry leaders from all over Thailand, including many of the Project L.I.F.E. leaders. Please pray for God's protection over all of us during this time.
